

Environmental Management System

In order to fulfil the aims of the environmental policy West Midland Safari Park has a management system in place made up of four components:

Members of the management staff keep **up to date with relevant legal requirements** and ensure the park complies with these (main parties responsible: Operations Manager, Director of Wildlife and Services Manager).

Green Team (committee of managers from key sections of the business) meets monthly to discuss progress towards current targets and organise required actions.

Chair of Green Team (Research and Conservation Officer) keeps an up to date '**Green Management File**' which holds information on water, energy and water management, details of current initiatives, records of yearly targets and copies of WMSP environmental policy and other relevant documentation.

Environmental review is carried out annually. This involves evaluation of previous year's achievement and, influenced by this, an updating of Environmental Management System and setting of targets for the coming year.
