



## DISCOVERY SESSIONS - KEY STAGE ONE

Functional skills are embedded throughout our sessions.

**Detailed below are the exciting range of education sessions that we offer Key Stage 1. All sessions last 45 minutes.**

### Discover Dinosaurs

Stomp, crash, RRRAGH! Watch out everyone - the dinosaurs are on the prowl! Join us on a journey through time and delve into this fascinating pre-historic world to learn about the different types of creatures that existed 65 million years ago. This is a great start to a dinosaur learning experience; children will especially enjoy having a closer look at some of our smaller, friendly animals and artefacts - can they spot the dinosaur similarities?!

### Animal Homes
